

Athletic Fee Guidelines

The purpose of the athletic fees is to raise funds to be used to offset costs associated with athletics at Palmer High School. Athletic fees must be paid before any student will be presented with an athletic uniform allowing that student to participate in any athletic contests, including scrimmages.

The following are guidelines developed to answer questions and to facilitate the administration and collection of said fees:

- 1) The athletic fee structure is as follows:
 - A) participation in one sport - \$150
 - B) participation in a second sport - \$100
 - C) participation in a third sport - \$50
- 2) Family Discount – A family that has more than one child participating in the sports program throughout the year will be provided with the following family discount:

Family Discount

	One Sport	Two Sports	Three Sports
First child	\$150	\$100	\$50
Second child	\$100	\$50	\$50
Three or more children	\$50	\$50	\$50

- 3) Waivers – Families of students experiencing financial hardships may submit a waiver application through the Athletic Director to the Superintendent of Schools. Approval of the waiver application is linked to federal free/reduced lunch family income eligibility requirements. A copy of the most recent federal 1040 tax return must be attached to the waiver application. - 4) Cheerleading is considered a year-long extra-curricula activity on the same par as an athletic sport.
- 5) Home-schooled or Pathfinder students will be assessed the same athletic fees as PHS students.
- 6) There will be no refunds of athletic fees.
